The Lamps of Old were said to have a Genie inside them... The First Tall Gas Flame Must have Looked like a Genie to ancient people. I've created clay lamps which produce a Tall Gas Flame on demand. A Strong, Stable 9 Inch Column of Fire Gas Flame, from a humble clay lamp. Please Freely Share This Device With Anyone You Know Who Could Use One.

Make Your Own Gas Lamp From Clay:

Clay is easily obtainable around the globe, as are Volcanic Ash Deposits (bentonite) to reduce the shrink rate of the clay. I add 20% Volcanic Ash to my terracotta clay to bring the shrink rate down from 14% to 8%, making the clay usable for making the gas lamps.

- 1) Begin with a 450 gram ball of clay
- 2) Make a Pinch Pot Bowl Shape
- 3) Bring the rims of the bowl together and seal to make "air taco"
- 4) Allow to slowly dry, with air bubble trapped inside, while Lamp is Shaped and smoothed.
- 5) Make sure Lamp Sits Level by Smacking it Gently on the table while still moist.
- 6) Once tacky, you need to make Two Holes, an Intake and the Fire's exhaust hole.
- 7) Make the holes Almost level, with the Fire Intake Slightly Above the Intake
- 8) Intake hole is slightly Larger than the Exhaust Hole.
- 9) Let Lamp Dry at least 4 days before putting into the coals of a fire to vitrify the lamp.
- 10) Lamp is ready to Use.

Lighting Your Own Clay Gas Lamp:

- 1) Any cotton wick will do, but the wick needs to be 4+ inches cotton or carbon felt.
- 2) Use Cheap Veggie oil as fuel, or any rendered fat from any animal.
- 3) Do not Over Fill The Lamp 90% of the Lamp must remain Empty in order to produce gas flame.
- 4) Light Cotton Wick, and Gently Push the Wick Down into the Middle of the Lamp. (this is difficult)
- 5) Lamp needs 5+ minutes to turn warm up enough to turn oil into smoke/gas. The Smoke/Gas should ignite on its own from the flame within, but you Can light the smoke, and or add another Wick near the exhaust hole if needed.
- 6) Lamp will burn tall gas flame for 45 minutes on 1/4 cup of veggie oil / bacon grease fuel. Any Low Smoke Point Oil works well. Avoid Higher smoke point oils like Olive Oil. Never use Petroleum oil.

My Lamps have saved the lives of people in winter. It is my hope my device and knowledge to create and use it reaches those who need it most, in Gaza.
